**NOTE:** PAWS only euthanizes animals who have untreatable illnesses/injuries, or whose behavior would make them a danger to the public if released. In 2020, 30% (24 of 81) of animals euthanized were ailing, suffering kittens with grave prognosis. Forty-four (44) adult cats and ten (10) dogs were euthanized because they were suffering from untreatable illnesses or injuries. Three (3) adult dogs were euthanized due to untreatable, aggressive behavior. Among animals who died, 83% (33 of 40) were kittens who succumbed to untreatable illness. Five (5) adult cats died due to untreatable illness. One (1) cat and two (2) dogs died due to surgical complication. The three animals listed as "Lost in Care" escaped from their foster homes and were not found despite extensive searching.
